Refuge this Week

This week we're beginning a short series in the Book of Job as we wrestle with one of the most honest questions we all ask: "Why?" Why does God do what He does? Why does He allow suffering? Why do faithful people walk through pain?

In Job 1–2, we'll see that Scripture doesn't ignore those questions, it meets them head-on. As we walk through the opening chapters, we'll discover that suffering reveals our faith and exposes what we truly value. We'll be reminded that suffering is never outside of God's sovereignty, that it can become a platform for worship, and that it is not the end of the story. Job teaches us that even when we don't receive all the answers to our "why," we can trust the One who is sovereign over them.
