In Jonah 4, we see Jonah's heart—and it's not a pretty picture. The Ninevites have just repented, and we would expect celebration. Instead, Jonah is angry. Even more revealing, he grieves more over a withered plant than over an entire city full of lost people. His reaction exposes a hard, self-righteous heart.

What makes it even more sobering is that Jonah wasn't a pagan, he was a prophet. He knew the Lord. And if we're honest, "church people" can drift into the same mindset. We can know all the right things about God and still have hearts that are misaligned with Him.

This week, I'll challenge the students with questions that uncover what's really going on beneath the surface: Will you still worship God when He writes a different story than the one you wanted? What are you truly living for? Are you depending on Christ or on your own effort? Is your heart broken for the lost?
